

2 – Link with the CIS process

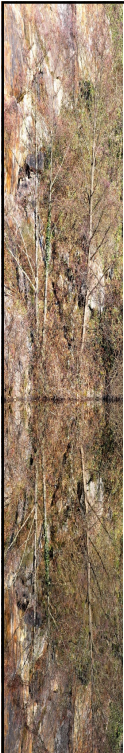
- to link current activities at national, regional and basine wide level with the **Common Implementation Strategy (CIS) process**;






